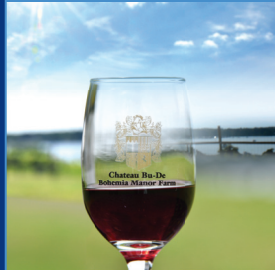

Crow Vineyard & Winery, Broken Spoke Winery & Winery and Chateau Bu-De Winery & Vineyard are all located in the River to Canal Wine Corridor on Maryland's Upper Eastern Shore. The location is at the smallest landmass area between two bays, the Delaware Bay and the Chesapeake Bay and with this configuration comes a bountiful grape growing region. The three wineries offer a trio of distinctive visitor experiences and award-winning wines to sip reflective of the terroir. One can experience all three wineries in a day or plan a longer weekend stay to take in the history of Chesapeake City to the north and Chestertown to the south of the corridor or the events offered at each winery.

From Bay Bridge & South

Do the Trio in a day -  
W, Th, Fri, Sat, Sun

Heading north from Chestertown start your trio tour at Crow when they open their tasting room at noon. Point north again and mid-afternoon take in Broken Spoke Winery. End your winery trio day at Chateau Bu-De open to 7 or 7:30 depending on day.



From 95 & North

Do the Trio in a day -  
Fri, Sat, Sun (Weekends)

Heading south from 95 or other points north start your trio tour at Chateau Bu-De 11 am. At 1 or 1:30 pm go over the Bohemia River Bridge to Broken Spoke. Then at 3 pm travel 20 min. to Crow and enjoy your visit there till close at 5 pm. Consider adding in a visit to Crow's Farmstay B&B!
